### PROJECTS - IN CLASS—60%: PRODUCT, CLASS ENGAGEMENT/ EFFORT, BEHAVIOR, CLEAN UP

- Projects must have your name on the back bottom left hand corner.

### VIRTUAL: 40%: SKETCHBOOK WORK AND ASSIGNMENTS, ENGAGEMENT/EFFORT, CONTACT
